Set for March 12-15**

Here is the schedule:

**Friday, March 12:** Arrive at the beautiful Dogwood Plantation in Cairo, Georgia. Optional quail hunting, skeet shooting and fishing available in the afternoon. Dinner on your own or group dinner will be held in the evening.

**Saturday, March 13:** We will start the day with a delicious country-style breakfast at the Plantation to be followed by our **Annual Pheasant Hunt**.
